

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CORPORATE INSOLVENCY RESOLUTION PROCESS (CIRP)

3 days

In continuation of our video 23rd and 24th

Insolvency commencement date for Corporate Debtor (CD) (Initiation of CIRP)

Commencement of Moratorium (till completion of CIRP/liquidation order)

Appt. of Interim resolution professional (RP) & suspension of Board of Directors of CD

Public Announcement for submission of claims (Form A)

- Mention last date for submission of claims + proofs - 14 days from appointment of IRP
- o English & Regional language newspaper (wide circulation at registered office & principal office location)
- Website of CD
- Website designated by IBBI

180 days (max. 330

days including any extension)

RP verify (7 days of receipt) & collate claims recd. & determine financial position

Formation of **Committee of** creditors (CoC) [Only Financial Creditors (FC)]

2 days

Report to **Adjudicating Authority** certifying constitution of CoC

7 days

RP give notice for 1st Meeting of CoC (agenda, Choice of VC/OAVM)

5 days

Meeting of CoC-66% voting (quorum - 33%) at the registered address

Appointment or **RP – Interim RP or** any other eligible person (66%) voting)

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Information Memorandum (IM) in e-form to each member of committee

Submission of resolution plan by resolution applicant (check eligibility) to RP

Approval of **Resolution plan** by RP, CoC (66%) & NCLT (Completion of CIRP)

RP to send a copy of the order of NCLT approving or rejecting the resolution plan to the participants and the resolution applicant

Duties of RP:

- Custody, Preserve & protect assets
- Represent & act on behalf of CD
- Raise finance
- Appoint professionals
- Maintain updated list of claims
- · Convene & attend meeting of CoC
- Prepare IM & Resolution plan & others as maybe required

2 weeks (up to 54th day of commencement)

15 days before the max. period for completion of CIRP

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- transferring, encumbering, alienating or disposing off assets • action to foreclose, recover or enforce any security interest created by CD (including SARFAESI)
- the recovery of any property by an owner or lessor occupied by CD

Made available/submitted to:

- Persons who submitted claims
- Members, partners, Directors and guarantors of CD

LIST OF CREDITORS

- Website of CD NCLT
- CoC- at their 1st meeting

In case of no Financial debt/FC of CD:

COMMITTEE OF CREDITORS

- 18 largest by value or all Operational creditors (lower), One workmen representative, One Employee representative
- Voting rights in proportion of the debt due to such creditor

• Statement for dealing with interest

RESOLUTION PLAN

- Details-if resolution applicant or any of its related party has failed or contributed to failure to implement any other RP
- Term & implementation Schedule
- Management & control of the business


